The Edmonton Ski Club (ESC) was victim to several acts of vandalism over the year. In December, vandals cut cables from a surface lift, tore out wiring in the T-bar lift electric panel and profane graffiti was written on the ski club's buildings. In January, the ESC was attacked again. This time a lift shack and its contents were destroyed and cables and equipment critical to the ski club's operation were damaged.

"In light of the vandalism we once again fought this past season, the Edmonton Ski Club is thrilled to announce that our long-time partner, Telsco Security, is installing a \$6000 security upgrade to our facilities," said Ken Saunders, Executive Director of the Edmonton Ski Club. "It is especially important that our security is updated given our work and involvement on the Gallagher Park Master Plan."

The ESC has faced financial difficulties that have made the future uncertain. The organization simply cannot afford to repair or replace facilities attacked by vandalism. Saunders commented that this contribution from Telsco Security will be a big help with that situation.
